

Top outdoor adventures along the 543km drive

TAMBO

Stroll the Coolibah Walk with its many swimming holes and fishing spots. Set up camp at Stubby Bend, perfect for the self-contained traveller. Discover the 'Rooftop of Queensland' on the stunning 4WD Wilderness Way Loop.

YARAKA

Have a great Aussie barbeque with awesome 360-degree views from nearby Mt Slowcombe. Gaze out at the Yang Yang ranges from your Yaraka campsite. Kick up some dust along bush tracks to the historic site of Magee's Shanty.

WINDORAH

Be spoilt for choice with beautiful campsites at Cooper Creek. Launch the tinny from sandy beach access points. Explore the 12 km off-road Nature Drive then head to the Windorah sandhills at sunset with nibbles and drinks.

BLACKALL

Relax and enjoy the calm at Barcoo Riverside camp just near town. Discover favourite fishing spots at 17 Mile and 18 Mile waterholes. Enjoy birdwatching, bushwalking, 4WDing and spotting wildlife at nearby Idalia National Park.

ISISFORD

Camp along the Barcoo at the weir within easy walking distance of town. Stay a few days at Oma waterhole popular for camping, fishing and boating. Discover a lifesize version of an ancient crocodile found in the area.
